




- This curriculum uses images and words.
 The images are found on the front.
 - The words are found on the back.



- 2. The images on the front and the words on the back go together.
 - For example, the top left image on the front corresponds with the top left image on the back.
 - Each row tells one story, poem, or prophecy.
 - Arrows pointing horizontally between boxes demonstrate the action in a story, poem, or prophecy is advancing.



3. More than one story, poem, or prophecy is included on each page.
For example, there are three stories on this particular page.
Arrows pointing vertically connect a scene from one story, poem, or prophecy to a similar scene in a second story, poem, or prophecy.



4. Some of the images include a star.

- The star indicates the main point being emphasized in a particular set of stories, poems, or prophecies.
- The main point is summarized at the bottom of the back page.

- 5. A color band behind the story, poem, or prophecy indicates the section
 - of Scripture from which that story, poem, or prophecy came.
 - The background colors originate from the Developing Leaders curriculum.
 - The following colors designate books from the Old Testament:
 - Blue represents the Law.




- Yellow represents the Prophets.
- Green represents the Writings.
- The following colors designate books from the New Testament: Orange represents the Gospels and Acts. Purple represents the Letters.
 - Pink represents Revelation.

6. This curriculum is designed to be printed and placed in a three-ring binder.

- It is designed to print on an 11" x 17" sheet of paper. This paper size is also called ledger paper.
- 2 thin gray lines on top and bottom of both sides indicates where the page should be folded to fit into a three-ring binder.
- Three faint circles on both sides indicates where the holes should be punched for use in a three-ring binder.
